Programme Requirements for Bachelor of Education with Honours (Chinese Language Teaching) and Bachelor of Language Studies with Honours (Applied Chinese Language Studies) (BEDHACLSJ)

To be eligible for the award of the **Bachelor of Education with Honours (Chinese Language Teaching) and Bachelor of Language Studies with Honours (Applied Chinese Language Studies)**, a student shall obtain the required number of credits specified for the Year of Entry, in courses prescribed and detailed in the course tables below.

For students admitted via Year 1 entry in or after 2021/22, via Year 2 entry in or after 2022/23 and via Year 3 entry in or after 2023/24, they must complete the four University Core Values Modules, namely Core Value I (Integrity), Core Value II (Fairness), Core Value III (Perseverance), and Core Value IV (Innovation) for graduation.

Year 1 Entry

A student admitted to the programme through Year 1 Entry is required to complete a total of 200 credits as prescribed below, of which no more than 40 credits should be taken at Foundation Level:

1. 165 credits of core courses in Tables 1, 2 and 3;
2. 5 credits of elective course from Table 4;
3. 5 credits of elective course from Table 5;
4. 15 credits of outside discipline courses in Table 6; and
5. 10 credits of purpose-designed General Education courses #.

Honours Classification

For the calculation of scores for classification purposes in the degree of **Bachelor of Education with Honours (Chinese Language Teaching)** and **Bachelor of Language Studies with Honours (Applied Chinese Language Studies)**. A total of 120 credits will be counted towards the Honours Classification.

1. Group (a) courses shall consist of 60 credits from Table 3 and shall be given 1.5 weighting towards the Honours Classification. The 60 credits include 45 credits from CHIN E366CF, CHIN E372CF, CHIN E373CF, CHIN E374CF, CHIN E375CF, EDU E401CF and EDU E472CF; and the best 15 credits from the remaining Higher level courses listed in Table 3.
2. The best 60 credits from Higher or Middle level courses listed in Tables 2, 3, 4 and 5, other than those of Group (a) courses, shall be defined as Group (b) courses and given single weighting towards the Honours Classification.
