Programme Requirements for Bachelor of Language Studies with Honours (Applied Chinese Language Studies) (BLSHACLSJ)

To be eligible for the award of the **Bachelor of Language Studies with Honours (Applied Chinese Language Studies)**, a student shall obtain the required number of credits specified for the Year of Entry, in courses prescribed and detailed in the course tables below.

For students admitted <u>in the 2022/23 academic year or thereafter</u>, please refer to Page 1 to 4. For students admitted **before the 2022/23 academic year**, please refer to Page 5 to 8.

For students admitted via Year 1 entry in or after 2021/22, via Year 2 entry in or after 2022/23 and via Year 3 entry in or after 2023/24, they must complete the four University Core Values Modules, namely Core Value I (Integrity), Core Value II (Fairness), Core Value III (Perseverance), and Core Value IV (Innovation) for graduation.

# For students admitted in the 2022/23 academic year or thereafter

## **Year 1 Entry**

A student admitted to the programme through Year 1 Entry is required to complete a total of 160 credits as prescribed below, of which no more than 40 credits should be taken at Foundation Level:

- 1. 110 credits of core courses in Tables 1, 2 and 3;
- 2. 5 credits of elective course from Table 4;
- 3. 5 credits of elective course from Table 5;
- 4. 20 credits of outside discipline courses from Table  $6^{*@}$ ; and
  - \* For students admitted through Year 1 Entry, please select two 5-credit English Language Enhancement courses from Table 6 in order to fulfill the requirements of 10 credits of English Language Enhancement courses.
  - ② Students are not allowed to take any outside discipline courses in the subject area 'CHIN' or 'PTH'. If students intend to take outside discipline courses not listed in Table 6, they should seek approval from the Programme Leader.
- 5. 20 credits (with at most 10 credits at the Foundation Level) of purpose-designed General Education courses #.

# **Year 2 Entry**

A student admitted to the programme through Year 2 Entry is required to complete a total of 120 credits as prescribed below, of which no more than 20 credits should be taken at Foundation Level:

- 1. 95 credits of core courses in Tables 2 and 3;
- 2. 5 credits of elective course from Table 4;
- 3. 5 credits of elective course from Table 5;
- 4. 5 credits of outside discipline courses from Table  $6^{@}$ ; and
  - @ Students are not allowed to take any outside discipline courses in the subject area 'CHIN' or 'PTH'. If students intend to take outside discipline courses not listed in Table 6, they should seek approval from the Programme Leader.
- 5. 10 credits of purpose-designed General Education courses #.

# **Year 3 Entry**

A student admitted to the programme through Year 3 Entry is required to complete a total of 80 credits as prescribed below:

- 1. 70 credits of core courses in Table 3;
- 2. 5 credits of elective course from Table 4; and
- 3. 5 credits of elective course from Table 5.

#### **Honours Classification**

For the calculation of scores for classification purpose in the degree of the **Bachelor of Language Studies with Honours (Applied Chinese Language Studies)** programme, 'Group (a) courses' shall consist of CHIN E365CF, CHIN E366CF, CHIN E372CF, CHIN E373CF, CHIN E374CF, CHIN E375CF and CHIN E430CF, and that 'Group (b) courses' shall consist of the best 40 credits in courses in Tables 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. For the calculation of the weighted grade point average (WGPA), Group (a) courses shall be weighted at twice the value of Group (b) courses.

#### For students admitted before 2022/23 academic year

# **Year 1 Entry**

A student admitted to the programme through Year 1 Entry is required to complete a total of 160 credits as prescribed below, of which no more than 40 credits should be taken at Foundation Level:

- 1. 110 credits of core courses in Tables 7, 8 and 9;
- 2. 5 credits of elective course from Table 10;
- 3. 5 credits of elective course from Table 11;
- 4. 20 credits of outside discipline courses from Table 12\*@; and
  - \* For students admitted through Year 1 Entry, please select two 5-credit English Language Enhancement courses from Table 6 in order to fulfill the requirements of 10 credits of English Language Enhancement courses.
  - @ Students are not allowed to take any outside discipline courses in the subject area 'CHIN' or 'PTH'. If students intend to take outside discipline courses not listed in Table 6, they should seek approval from the Programme Leader.
- 5. 20 credits (with at most 10 credits at the Foundation Level) of purpose-designed General Education courses #.

#### Year 2 Entry

A student admitted to the programme through Year 2 Entry is required to complete a total of 120 credits as prescribed below, of which no more than 20 credits should be taken at Foundation Level:

- 1. 95 credits of core courses in Tables 8 and 9;
- 2. 5 credits of elective course from Table 10;
- 3. 5 credits of elective course from Table 11;
- 4. 5 credits of outside discipline courses from Table  $12^{@}$ ; and
  - @ Students are not allowed to take any outside discipline courses in the subject area 'CHIN' or 'PTH'. If students intend to take outside discipline courses not listed in Table 6, they should seek approval from the Programme Leader.
- 5. 10 credits of purpose-designed General Education courses #.
