**Programme Requirements for Bachelor of Nursing with Honours in General Health Care (BNHGJ1)**

To be eligible for the award of the **Bachelor of Nursing with Honours in General Health Care**, a student shall obtain the required number of credits specified, in courses prescribed and detailed in the course tables below.

For students admitted in the 2021/22 academic year or thereafter, please refer to Page 1 to 2.

For students admitted before the 2021/22 academic year, please refer to Page 3 to 4.

***For students admitted in the 2021/22 academic year or thereafter***

For students admitted via Year 1 entry in or after 2021/22, via Year 2 entry in or after 2022/23 and via Year 3 entry in or after 2023/24, they must complete the four University Core Values Modules, namely Core Value I (Integrity), Core Value II (Fairness), Core Value III (Perseverance), and Core Value IV (Innovation) for graduation.

A student admitted to the programme is required to complete a total of 200 credits as prescribed below, of which no more than 50 credits should be taken at Foundation Level:

1. 180 credits of core courses in Table 1;
2. 20 credits of purpose-designed General Education courses<sup>#</sup> in which 10 credits should be taken at Middle level.

### Honours Classification

For the purpose of the honours classification of the **Bachelor of Nursing with Honours in General Health Care** programme, relevant courses are categorized as Groups (a) and (b) as shown in Table 1 above. The weighted grade point average (WGPA) will be calculated as follows:

- (1) Group (a) shall consist of the best 40 credits in courses at Higher level.
- (2) Group (b) shall consist of the best 40 credits in courses at Middle or Higher level, where such credits are not taken into account in Group (a).
- (3) Group (a) and (b) courses carry equal weighting when calculating WGPA.

***For students admitted before the 2021/22 academic year***

A student admitted to the programme is required to complete a total of 200 credits as prescribed below, of which no more than 50 credits should be taken at Foundation Level:

1. 180 credits of core courses in Table 2; and
2. 20 credits of purpose-designed General Education courses<sup>#</sup> in which 10 credits should be taken at Middle level.

**Honours Classification**

For the purpose of the honours classification of the **Bachelor of Nursing with Honours in General Health Care** programme, relevant courses are categorized as Groups (a) and (b) as shown in Table 2 above. The weighted grade point average (WGPA) will be calculated as follows:

- (1) Group (a) shall consist of the best 40 credits in courses at Higher level.
- (2) Group (b) shall consist of the best 40 credits in courses at Middle or Higher level, where such credits are not taken into account in Group (a).
- (3) Group (a) and (b) courses carry equal weighting when calculating WGPA.
