

Terms and Conditions

1. The event registration works on a first-come, first-served basis. The Development and Alumni Affairs Office (DAAO) of the Hong Kong Metropolitan University (the University) reserves the right to limit and refuse any registrations.
2. For the "Chess Simultaneous Exhibition" activity during this event, the maximum number of participants per team is two. A maximum of 20 teams will be allowed, and spots will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
3. The event is exclusive for Hong Kong Metropolitan University Alumni Association (HKMUAA) members. Each enrolled member will be allowed to invite at most 3 guests to the event and will be required to show the HKMUAA membership e-card as identity proof.
4. The event may be subject to change according to the weather conditions of the day. If a Red Rainstorm Warning/ Black Rainstorm Warning/ Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above/ Landslip Warning is issued before 11:00am on the event day, the activity will be cancelled. DAAO will inform participants through SMS and announce the change of date or other arrangements later.
5. Participants must adhere to the instructions provided by the university staff throughout the duration of the event. If any equipment, apparatus, device, or other property is damaged or destroyed (excluding normal wear and tear), stolen, or removed, the University reserves the right to claim corresponding compensation for the loss.
6. Any individual who engages in behavior deemed inappropriate or indecent by the University or DAAO may be refused entry or asked to leave the premises. The University and DAAO reserve the right to control admission and make the final decision in such matters.
7. Participants should take care and safeguard their personal belongings. The University is not responsible for any loss or damage to the personal belongings.
8. Each participant will receive a gift and a game voucher. All gifts are non-transferable, non-exchangeable, non-refundable, and cannot be converted into cash or other gifts. Gifts are available while supplies last. The University will not be responsible for any loss or theft of gifts once they have been received by participants.
9. All personal data provided will be used for enrollment and event organisation, future communications with the University and HKMUAA including latest news of University and alumni development, alumni promotion activities, fundraising appeals, acknowledgement and record, etc.
