

Terms and Conditions

1. Due to limited quotas, the event will be enrolled on a first-come-first-served basis. The Development and Alumni Affairs Office (DAAO) reserves the right to limit and refuse any enrollment.
2. The event is an alumni-exclusive activity and enrolment for non-alumni without the participation of HKMU alumni is not allowed. Enrolled alumni should attend the event in person and will be required to show alumni e-card as identity proof.
3. DAAO reserves the right to disqualify participants who fail to complete the payment during the designated period. The vacant quota will then be redistributed to other registrants by DAAO. Once the enrollment is confirmed, no refund or change will be allowed unless the event is cancelled.
4. Participants who wish to take the coach arranged by the University should arrive on time at the meeting point. Late comers will not be entertained.
5. The event may be subject to change according to the weather conditions of the day. If a Red Rainstorm Warning / Black Rainstorm Warning/ Typhoon Signal No. 8 or above/ Landslip Warning is issued before 6:30 am on the event day, the activity will be cancelled. DAAO will inform participants through SMS and announce the change of date or other arrangements later.
6. Participation in the event is voluntary and participants should assess their health conditions and take all unexpected risks and responsibilities directly or indirectly relating to or arising from the event. DAAO shall not be liable for any accidents, injuries or death of participants during the event.
7. Participants should comply with the rules and instructions given by the farm and DAAO staff to avoid any accidents. Participants aged under 18 should be accompanied by their parents or guardians. DAAO reserves the right to disqualify participants who fail to comply with the rules and commit any conduct, which arouses nuisance to others or engage in other acts deemed inappropriate by DAAO. No refund will be made to the participant.
8. Participants should take care and safeguard their personal belongings. The farm and DAAO are not responsible for any loss or damage to the personal belongings.
9. Participants are advised to wear casual wear and sports shoes, and bring their sunscreen, umbrella or mosquito repellent if necessary.
10. Every participant will be given a barbeque set and drinks. Participants could also bring their own food and drinks or purchase them at the farm if necessary.
11. Participants should take all unexpected risks and responsibilities if they leave during the event.
12. Please keep the farm clean and do not litter.
13. DAAO has purchased travel accident insurance for every participant, providing protection of up to \$200,000 (coverage includes permanent disablement or accidental death).

14. All personal data provided will only be used for enrollment and event organization. DAAO reserves the right to take photos, videos or recordings in other forms during the event, and use them for any legitimate purpose without prior approval of participants or provision of any reward.
15. Participants must accept and agree to abide by the terms and conditions listed herein.
16. DAAO reserves the right to cancel, postpone or make any kind of adjustment in the event.
17. DAAO reserves the right to amend the above information without prior notice. In case of any discrepancy between the Chinese and English versions of the terms and conditions, the Chinese version will prevail.
