Mr David Chan Ting-chuen is Chairman of Build Tech Holdings Limited. Prior to that, he was the Chairman and Executive Director of Symphony Holdings Limited, a listed company in Hong Kong.

Mr Chan obtained his Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering from the University of Hong Kong and ventured into the business sector upon graduation. Over the years he has made glorious achievements in his business undertakings through sheer diligence and unswerving persistence. He assumed directorship of a number of listed companies with exemplary accomplishments.

With his wealth of knowledge in business, Mr Chan offered his expertise and served as a member at the HKSAR Customs and Excise Service Children's Education Trust Fund Investment Advisory Board from 2000 to 2004.
