

## Programme Requirements for Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Language and Translation

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in  
2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

### 1. Programme Requirement

- 1.1 To be eligible for the award of the Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Language and Translation (BALTH), a student shall:
- 1.1.1 obtain 120 credit-units as prescribed below, of which no more than 30 credit-units shall be at 1000-level, at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
- 1.1.1.1 78 credit-units of core courses labelled CC in Table 1;
  - 1.1.1.2 21 credit-units of core elective courses labelled CE in Table 1;
  - 1.1.1.3 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
  - 1.1.1.4 6 credit-units of University English courses labelled UEC in Table 1;
  - 1.1.1.5 6 credit-units from any undergraduate courses offered by the University at 1000-level or above;
- and
- 1.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.
