

## Programme Requirements for Bachelor of Social Sciences with Honours and Bachelor of Social Sciences

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

## 1. Programme Requirement - Bachelor of Social Sciences with Honours (BSSH)

- 1.1 To be eligible for the award of the Bachelor of Social Sciences with Honours (BSSH), a student shall:
  - 1.1.1 obtain 120 credit-units\* as prescribed below, of which no more than 30 credit-units shall be at 1000-level, at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
    - 1.1.1.1 12 credit-units of a core course labelled CC (i.e. either SOSC 4001AED or SOSC 4001ACD) from Table 1;
    - 1.1.1.2 12 credit-units of 1000-level core courses labelled FC in Table 1;
    - 1.1.1.3 24 credit-units of major concentration courses labelled CN from Table 1;
    - 1.1.1.4 12 credit-units of elective courses in specific area labelled ECS from Table 1;
    - 1.1.1.5 36 credit-units of elective courses labelled CN, ECS and EC from Table 1;
    - 1.1.1.6 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
    - 1.1.1.7 6 credit-units of University English courses labelled UEC in Table 1;
    - 1.1.1.8 9 credit-units from any 1000-/2000-/3000-/4000-level courses offered by the University;
    - \*Of the 120 credit-units required for BSSH, students can complete no more than 40 credit-units of courses in a language of instruction other than English.

and

1.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

## 2. Programme Requirement - Bachelor of Social Sciences (BSS)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the Bachelor of Social Sciences (BSS), a student shall:
  - 2.1.1 obtain 90 credit-units\* as prescribed below, of which no more than 30 credit-units shall be at 1000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level:



- 2.1.1.1 12 credit-units of 1000-level core courses labelled FC in Table 1;
- 2.1.1.2 24 credit-units of major concentration courses labelled CC, CN and ECS from Table 1;
- 2.1.1.3 33 credit-units of elective courses labelled CC, CN, ECS and EC from Table 1;
- 2.1.1.4 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
- 2.1.1.5 6 credit-units of University English courses labelled UEC in Table 1;
- 2.1.1.6 6 credit-units from any 1000-/2000-/3000-/4000-level courses offered by the University;

and

2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.
