

**Programme Requirements for
Bachelor of Social Sciences with Honours in Law Enforcement and Security Management
and Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management
(Applicable to Certificate of Law Enforcement and Security Management/ Customs
Management (CLECMCF/CLESMCF) award holders)**

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in
2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

1. Entry Requirement

- 1.1 To enter the **Bachelor of Social Sciences with Honours in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 3 (BSSLESMH3)**, a student shall be a graduate of the Certificate of Law Enforcement and Security Management (CLESMCF) or Certificate of Law Enforcement and Customs Management (CLECMCF) who has obtained the Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management plus two subsequent years of working experience in the Customs and Excise Department (applicable to CLECMCF graduate) / the Hong Kong Police Force (applicable to CLESMCF graduate).

- 1.2 To enter the **Bachelor of Social Sciences with Honours in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 4 (BSSLESMH4)** or the **Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (BSSLESM1)** programme, a student shall be a graduate of the Certificate of Law Enforcement and Security Management (CLESMCF) or Certificate of Law Enforcement and Customs Management (CLECMCF).

1. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management with Honours through Pathway 3 (BSSLESMH3)

- 1.1 To be eligible for the award of Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management with Honours through Pathway 3 (BSSLESMH3), a student shall:
 - 1.1.1 obtain 60 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
 - 1.1.1.1 6 credit-units of 3000-level core courses labelled CC3 in Table 1;
 - 1.1.1.2 6 credit-units of 4000-level core courses labelled CC4 in Table 1;
 - 1.1.1.3 3 credit-units of 2000-level elective courses labelled EC2 from Table 1;
 - 1.1.1.4 18 credit-units of 3000-level elective courses labelled EC3 from Table 1;
 - 1.1.1.5 18 credit-units of 4000-level elective courses labelled EC4 from Table 1;
 - 1.1.1.6 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

- 1.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

2. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management with Honours through Pathway 4 (BSSLESMH4)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management with Honours through Pathway 4 (BSSLESMH4), a student shall:

- 2.1.1 obtain 99 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:

- 2.1.1.1 12 credit-units of 2000-level core courses labelled CC from Table 1;
- 2.1.1.2 15 credit-units of 3000-level core courses labelled CC3 in Table 1;
- 2.1.1.3 9 credit-units of 4000-level core courses labelled CC4 in Table 1;
- 2.1.1.4 24 credit-units of 2000-level elective courses labelled EC2 from Table 1;
- 2.1.1.5 12 credit-units of 3000-level elective courses labelled EC3 from Table 1;
- 2.1.1.6 18 credit-units of 4000-level elective courses labelled EC4 from Table 1;
- 2.1.1.7 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

- 2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

3. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (BSSLESM1)

- 3.1 To be eligible for the award of Bachelor of Social Sciences in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (BSSLESM1), a student shall:

- 3.1.1 obtain 60 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level:

- 3.1.1.1 12 credit-units of core courses labelled CC in Table 1;
- 3.1.1.2 18 credit-units of 3000-/4000-level core courses labelled CC3 and CC4 from Table 1;
- 3.1.1.3 15 credit-units of 2000-level elective courses labelled EC2 from Table 1;
- 3.1.1.4 6 credit-units of 3000/4000-level elective courses labelled EC3 and EC4 from Table 1;
- 3.1.1.5 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

- 3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.
