

Programme Requirements for

Higher Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management and Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management (Applicable to Certificate of Law Enforcement and Security Management (CLESMCF)/ Certificate of Law Enforcement and Customs Management (CLECMCF) award holders)

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

- 1. Entry Requirement
 - 1.1 To enter the Higher Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (HDLESMA1) or the Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (DLESMA1) programme, a student shall:
 - 1.1.1 be a graduate of CLECMCF or CLESMCF.

2. Programme Requirement – Higher Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (HDLESMA1)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the Higher Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (HDLESMA1), a student shall:
 - 2.1.1 obtain 39 credit-units as prescribed below:
 - 2.1.1.1 12 credit-units of core courses labelled CC in Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.2 15 credit-units of 2000-level elective courses labelled EC2 from Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.3 6 credit-units of 3000-/4000-level core courses labelled CC3 and CC4 from Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.4 6 credit-units of 3000/4000-level elective courses labelled EC3 and EC4 from Table 1;

and

2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of sub-degrees.

3. Programme Requirement – Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (DLESMA1)

- 3.1 To be eligible for the award of the Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management through Pathway 1 (DLESMA1), a student shall:
 - 3.1.1 obtain 24 credit-units as prescribed below:
 - 3.1.1.1 12 credit-units of core courses labelled CC from Table 1;



- 3.1.1.2 6 credit-units of 2000-level elective courses labelled EC2 from Table 1;
- 3.1.1.3 6 credit-units of 3000-/4000-level core courses labelled EC3 and EC4 from Table 1;

and

3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of sub-degrees.
