## **Programme Requirements for**

# Higher Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management, Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management, and Certificate in Law Enforcement and Security Management (Applicable to students without the Certificate of Law Enforcement and Security Management (CLESMCF)/ Certificate of Law Enforcement and Customs Management (CLECMCF))

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

- 1. Programme Requirement Higher Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management (HDLESMA)
  - 1.1 To be eligible for the award of the Higher Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management (HDLESMA), a student shall:
    - 1.1.1 obtain 60 credit-units\* as prescribed below, of which at least 6 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level:
      - 1.1.1.1 18 credit-units of core courses labelled CC from Table 1;
      - 1.1.1.2 12 credit-units of 3000-/4000-level core courses labelled CC3 and CC4 from Table 1;
      - 1.1.1.3 12 credit-units of 1000-level elective courses labelled EC1 from Table 1;
      - 1.1.1.4 18 credit-units of 2000-level elective courses labelled EC2 from Table 1;

\*Of the 60 credit-units required for HDLESMA, students can complete no more than 20 credit-units of courses in a language of instruction other than English.

and

1.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

### 2. Programme Requirement – Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management (DLESMA)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the Diploma in Law Enforcement and Security Management (DLESMA), a student shall:
  - 2.1.1 obtain 45 credit-units\* as prescribed below, of which at least 15 credit-units shall be at 2000-level:
    - 2.1.1.1 12 credit-units of core courses labelled CC from Table 1;
    - 2.1.1.2 9 credit-units of 1000-level elective courses labelled EC1 from Table 1;



- 2.1.1.3 18 credit-units of 2000-level elective courses labelled EC2 from Table 1;
- 2.1.1.4 6 credit-units of 3000-/4000-level core courses labelled CC3 and CC4 from Table 1;

\*Of the 45 credit-units required for DLESMA, students can complete no more than 15 credit-units of courses in a language of instruction other than English.

and

2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of sub-degrees.

### 3. Programme Requirement – Certificate in Law Enforcement and Security Management (CLESMA)

- 3.1 To be eligible for the award of the Certificate in Law Enforcement and Security Management (CLESMA), a student shall:
  - 3.1.1 obtain 18 credit-units as prescribed below:
    - 3.1.1.1 12 credit-units of core courses labelled CC from Table 1;
    - 3.1.1.2 6 credit-units of 1000-level elective courses labelled EC1 from Table 1;

\*Of the 18 credit-units required for DLESMA, students can complete no more than 6 credit-units of courses in a language of instruction other than English.

and

3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of sub-degrees.
