

## Programme Requirements for Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours

### 1. Entry Requirement

- 1.1 To enter the Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours programme through Pathway 1, a student shall normally possess a recognized Associate Degree or Higher Diploma in a business-related area (or its equivalent).
- 1.2 To enter the Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours programme through Pathway 2, a student shall normally possess a recognized Associate Degree or Higher Diploma in a sports-related area (or its equivalent).

### 2. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours (BSMH)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours, a student shall:
  - 2.1.1 obtain 120 credit-units as prescribed below, of which no more than 30 credit-units shall be at 1000-level, at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
    - 2.1.1.1 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
    - 2.1.1.2 87 credit-units of concentration core courses labelled CNC in Table 1;
    - 2.1.1.3 18 credit-units of concentration elective course labelled CNE from Table 1;
    - 2.1.1.4 6 credit-units, as necessary, from any English and/or Chinese courses at 1000/2000/3000/4000-level offered by the University.
- and
- 2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Undergraduate Degrees.

### 3. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours (through Pathway 1) (BSMH1)

- 3.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours through Pathway 1, a student shall:
  - 3.1.1 obtain 63 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
    - 3.1.1.1 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
    - 3.1.1.2 36 credit-units of BUS 3027BED, SPM 4012BED and SPM 4036BED from Table 1;
    - 3.1.1.3 18 credit-units of **SPM 3039BED** from Table 1.

and

3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Undergraduate Degrees.

#### 4. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours (through Pathway 2) (BSMH2)

4.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of Bachelor of Sports Management with Honours through Pathway 2, a student shall:

4.1.1 obtain 63 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:

4.1.1.1 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

4.1.1.2 36 credit-units of BUS 3027BED, SPM 4012BED and SPM 4036BED from Table 1;

4.1.1.3 18 credit-units of **MGT 3008BED** from Table 1.

and

4.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Undergraduate Degrees.
