

Programme Requirements for Associate of General Studies

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

1. Programme Requirement – Associate of General Studies (AGST)

- 1.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Associate of General Studies (AGST), a student shall:
- 1.1.1 obtain at least 60 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 30 credit-units shall be at 2000-/3000-level:
 - 1.1.1.1 at least 54 credit-units from any undergraduate courses offered by the University at 1000-level or above, of which at least 27 credit-units shall be at 2000-/3000-level;
 - 1.1.1.2 6 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;
- and
- 1.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.
