

Programme Requirements for Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours and Bachelor of Language Studies (English)

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

1. Entry Requirement

- 1.1 To enter the **Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours through Pathway 1** or **the Bachelor of Language Studies (English) through Pathway 1**, a student shall:
 - 1.1.1 possess a recognized Associate Degree, Higher Diploma, or equivalent, in an area related to English studies.
- 1.2 To enter the Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours through Pathway 2 or the Bachelor of Language Studies (English) through Pathway 2, a student shall:
 - 1.2.1 possess a recognized Associate Degree, Higher Diploma, or equivalent, in an area not related to English studies.

2. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours (BLSENGH)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours, a student shall:
 - 2.1.1 obtain 120 credit-units as prescribed below, of which no more than 30 credit-units shall be at 1000-level, at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
 - 2.1.1.1 24 credit-units of core courses labelled CF, CC and CC1 in Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.2 75 credit-units of concentration courses labelled CN, CN1, EC, EC1, EC2, EC3 and EC4 in Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.3 12 credit-units from any 1000-/2000-/3000-/4000-level courses offered by the University;
 - 2.1.1.4 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.



3. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours through Pathway 1 (BLSENGH1)

- 3.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours through Pathway 1, a student shall:
 - 3.1.1 obtain 60 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
 - 3.1.1.1 3 credit-units of core course ENGL 2205EED labelled CC1 in Table 1;
 - 3.1.1.2 6 credit-units of concentration course ENGL 3320EED labelled CN1 in Table 1;
 - 3.1.1.3 12 credit-units from elective course labelled CN in Table 1;
 - 3.1.1.4 18 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC1, EC1H and EC3 in Table 1;
 - 3.1.1.5 12 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC2 and EC4 in Table 1;
 - 3.1.1.6 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

4. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours through Pathway 2 (BLSENGH2)

- 4.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Bachelor of Language Studies (English) with Honours through Pathway 2, a student shall:
 - 4.1.1 obtain 90 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 4000-level:
 - 4.1.1.1 15 credit-units of core courses labelled CC and CC1 in Table 1;
 - 4.1.1.2 30 credit-units of concentration courses labelled CN and CN1 in Table 1;

4.1.1.3 18 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC1, EC1H and EC3 in Table 1;

- 4.1.1.4 18 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC2 and EC4 in Table 1;
- 4.1.1.5 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

- 4.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.
- 5. Programme Requirement Bachelor of Language Studies (English) (BLSENG)



- 5.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Bachelor of Language Studies (English), a student shall:
 - 5.1.1 obtain 90 credit-units as prescribed below, of which no more than 30 credit-units shall be at 1000-level and at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level:
 - 5.1.1.1 24 credit-units of core courses labelled CF, CC and CC1 in Table 1;
 - 5.1.1.2 30 credit-units of concentration courses labelled CN and CN1 in Table 1;
 - 5.1.1.3 15 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC1, EC1H and EC2 in Table 1;
 - 5.1.1.4 9 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC, EC3 and EC4 in Table 1;
 - 5.1.1.5 3 credit-units from any 1000-/2000-/3000-/4000-level courses offered by the University;
 - 5.1.1.6 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

5.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

6. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Language Studies (English) through Pathway 1 (BLSENG1)

- 6.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Bachelor of Language Studies (English) through Pathway 1, a student shall:
 - 6.1.1 obtain 36 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level:
 - 6.1.1.1 3 credit-units of core course ENGL 2205EED labelled CC1 in Table 1;
 - 6.1.1.2 6 credit-units of concentration course ENGL 3320EED labelled CN1 in Table 1;
 - 6.1.1.3 12 credit-units of elective course labelled CN in Table 1;
 - 6.1.1.4 3 credit-units from elective course labelled EC1 and EC2 in Table 1;
 - 6.1.1.5 3 credit-units from elective course labelled EC3 and EC4 in Table 1;
 - 6.1.1.6 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

6.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.

7. Programme Requirement – Bachelor of Language Studies (English) through Pathway 2 (BLSENG2)

7.1 To be eligible for the award of the award of Bachelor of Language Studies (English) through Pathway 2, a student shall:



- 7.1.1 obtain 60 credit-units as prescribed below, of which at least 24 credit-units shall be at 3000-/4000-level:
 - 7.1.1.1 15 credit-units of course courses labelled CC and CC1 in Table 1;
 - 7.1.1.2 30 credit-units of concentration courses labelled CN and CN1 in Table 1;
 - 7.1.1.3 3 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC1 and EC2 in Table 1;
 - 7.1.1.4 3 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC3 and EC4 in Table 1;
 - 7.1.1.5 9 credit-units of University Core courses labelled UCC in Table 1;

and

7.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the award of undergraduate degrees.
