

Programme Requirements for Master of Education in Early Childhood Education

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

1. Entry Requirement

- 1.1 To enter the **Master of Education in Early Childhood Education** programme, a student should:
- 1.1.1 hold a Bachelor's degree from a recognized tertiary education institution, or the equivalent;
 - 1.1.2 possess a recognized teacher's qualification; and
 - 1.1.3 possess at least two years' teaching or training experience.

2. Programme Requirement - Master of Education in Early Childhood Education (MEDUECE)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Education in Early Childhood Education**, a student shall:
- 2.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:
 - 2.1.1.1 27 credit-units from all compulsory courses labelled CC in Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.2 3 credit-units of elective courses labelled EC in Table 1;
- and
- 2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
