

Programme Requirements for Doctor of Education

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

1. Period of Study and Entry Requirement

1.1 A student shall complete the **Doctor of Education** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

Professional Doctoral Degree	Maximum Period of Study*	Time frame for submission of thesis	
Full-time	4 years	No less than one and no more than two years after a student's first registration for the thesis of the doctoral degree with coursework components.	
Part-time	8 years	No less than two and no more than five years after a student's first registration for the thesis of the doctoral degree with coursework components.	

^{*}The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.

- 1.2 To enter the **Doctor of Education** programme, a student should:
 - 1.2.1 hold a recognized Master's degree (by research or coursework) in education or a related area; and
 - 1.2.2 satisfy the University English language proficiency requirements.

2. Programme Requirement – Doctor of Education (EDD)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of Doctor of Education, a student shall:
 - 2.1.1 obtain 24 credit-units as prescribed below:
 - 2.1.1.1 9 credit-units from the compulsory course EDU 9991EED labelled CC in Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.2 15 credit-units from elective courses labelled EC and RM in Table 1[^], of which at least 3 credit-units must be from courses labelled RM;
 - ^ Students may choose other courses offered by School of Education and Languages subject to School Research Degrees Committee (SRDC)'s recommendation and University's approval.
 - 2.1.1.3 successful completion of the EDD Thesis labelled ET in Table 1;

and

2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
