

Programme Requirements for Master of Arts in Cultural Leadership

1. Period of Study and Entry Requirement

- 1.1. A student shall complete the **Master of Arts in Cultural Leadership** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

Normative Period of Study	Maximum Period of Study*
1 year (full-time)	3 years (full-time)
2 years (part-time)	4 years (part-time)

**The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.*

- 1.2. To enter the **Master of Arts in Cultural Leadership** programme, a student should:
- 1.2.1 possess a Bachelor's degree in any discipline(s) from a recognized institution or the equivalent; and
 - 1.2.2 satisfy the University's English language proficiency requirements.

2. Programme Requirement – Master of Arts in Cultural Leadership (MACULEF)

- 2.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Arts in Cultural Leadership**, a student shall:
- 2.1.1 obtain 33 credit-units as prescribed below:
 - 2.1.1.1 30 credit-units from all core courses labelled CA in Table 1;
 - 2.1.1.2 3 credit-units from elective courses labelled EA in Table 1;
 - and
 - 2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
