

Programme Requirements for Master of Education in English Language Education

This 3-credit-unit system programme requirements document is applicable to students admitted in 2023 Autumn term and thereafter.

1. Period of Study and Entry Requirement

1.1 A student shall complete the **Master of Education in English Language Education** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

Normative Period of Study	Maximum Period of Study*
2 years (part-time)	4 years (part-time)

^{*}The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.

- 1.2 To enter the **Master of Education in English Language Education** programme, a student should obtain:
 - 1.2.1 a recognized Bachelor's degree (or its equivalent);
 - 1.2.2 normally, a recognized teacher qualification and/or at least two years of teaching or training experience; and
 - 1.2.3 satisfy the University English language proficiency requirements.

Applicants without relevant qualifications/experience may be admitted where the School of Education and Languages considers their background suitable for Master's level study in Education.

2. Articulation of Qualifications

- 2.1 The Regulations Governing the Articulation of Qualifications shall apply for conversion of the Postgraduate Diploma in English Studies for Language Teaching (PGDESLTF) to the award of Master of Education in English Language Education.
- 3. Programme Requirement Master of Education in English Language Education (MEDELEF)
 - 3.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of Master of Education in English Language Education, a student shall:
 - 3.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:
 - 3.1.1.1 27 credit-units from all compulsory courses labelled ELE in Table 1;
 - 3.1.1.2 3 credit-units from one of the elective courses labelled RM in Table 1;

and

3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
