

## Programme Requirements for Postgraduate Diploma in English Studies for Language Teaching

### 1. Period of Study and Entry Requirement

- 1.1 A student shall complete the **Postgraduate Diploma in English Studies for Language Teaching** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

Normative Period of Study	Maximum Period of Study*
2 years (part-time)	4 years (part-time)

*\*The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.*

- 1.2 To enter the **Postgraduate Diploma in English Studies for Language Teaching** programme, a student should obtain:

- 1.2.1 a recognized Bachelor's degree (or its equivalent);
- 1.2.2 normally, a recognized teacher qualification and/or at least two years of teaching or training experience; and
- 1.2.3 satisfy the University English language proficiency requirements.

*Applicants without relevant qualifications/experience may be admitted where the School of Education and Languages considers their background suitable for Master's level study in Education.*

### 2. Programme Requirement - Postgraduate Diploma in English Studies for Language Teaching (PGDESLTF)

- 2.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Postgraduate Diploma in English Studies for Language Teaching**, a student shall:

- 2.1.1 obtain 18 credit-units from all compulsory courses in Table 1;
- and
- 2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
