

## Programme Requirements for Master of Nursing (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing / with specialization in Management and Leadership)

### 1. Period of Study and Entry Requirement

- 1.1. A student shall complete the **Master of Nursing** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

| Normative Period of Study | Maximum Period of Study* |
|---------------------------|--------------------------|
| 1 year (full-time)        | 3 years (full-time)      |
| 2 years (part-time)       | 4 years (part-time)      |

*\*The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.*

- 1.2. To enter the **Master of Nursing** programme, a student should:

- 1.2.1 be a Registered Nurse with valid professional and practicing certificates issued by Nursing Council of Hong Kong (for Hong Kong students);
- or
- be a nurse with recognized professional and practicing qualification issued by the relevant professional body outside Hong Kong (for non-local students);
- 1.2.2 hold a recognized Bachelor's degree in Nursing or health-related discipline; and
- 1.2.3 satisfy the University's English language proficiency requirements.

### 2. Programme Requirement – Master of Nursing (with specialization in Advanced Respiratory Nursing) (MNARNF)

- 2.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of Master of Nursing, a student shall:

- 2.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:

2.1.1.1 15 credit-units from all compulsory courses labelled CC in Table 1;

2.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all Advanced Respiratory Nursing specialization courses labelled RN in Table 1;

and

- 2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.

### 3. Programme Requirement – Master of Nursing (with specialization in Management and Leadership) (MNMLF)

- 3.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of Master of Nursing, a student shall:

- 3.1.1 obtain 30 credit-units as prescribed below:

3.1.1.1 15 credit-units from all compulsory courses labelled CC in Table 1;

3.1.1.2 15 credit-units from all Management and Leadership specialization courses labelled ML in Table 1;

and

3.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
