

Programme Requirements for Master of Science in Extensive End-of-Life Care

1. Duration of Study and Entry Requirement

1.1. A student shall complete the **Master of Science in Extensive End-of-Life Care** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

^{*}The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.

- 1.2. To enter the **Master of Science in Extensive End-of-Life Care** programme, a student should:
 - 1.2.1. hold a Bachelor's degree in health-related disciplines from a recognized institution or equivalent qualification; and
 - 1.2.2. satisfy the University English language proficiency requirements.

2. Programme Requirement

- 2.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Master of Science in Extensive End-of-Life Care**, a student shall:
 - 2.1.1. successfully complete 30 credit-units from all compulsory courses in Table 1. and
 - 2.1.2. attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
