

Programme Requirements for Master of Computing

1. Period of Study and Entry Requirement

1.1. A student shall complete the **Master of Computing** programme within the prescribed periods as stipulated below:

Normative Period of Study Maximum Period of Study*		
1 year (full-time)	3 years (full-time)	
2 years (part-time)	4 years (part-time)	

^{*}The maximum period of study shall include any periods of leave of absence and deferment of studies.

- 1.2. To enter the **Master of Computing** programme, a student should:
 - 1.2.1 hold a Bachelor's degree in any non-IT related discipline from a recognized tertiary institution or equivalent qualification; and
 - 1.2.2 satisfy the University's English language proficiency requirements.

2. Programme Requirement – Master of Computing (MCOMPF)

- 2.1. To be eligible for the award of the degree of Master of Computing, a student shall:
 - 2.1.1 obtain 33 credit-units from all compulsory courses in Table 1;

and

2.1.2 attain the CGPA for graduation as prescribed in the Regulations for the Award of Postgraduate Degrees.
