## Regulations for the degree of Bachelor of Nursing

### 1. General

- 1.1 These regulations are made under paragraphs 1 to 4 of the Regulations for the Award of Undergraduate Degrees.
- 1.2 In these regulations definitions shall apply as in the Regulations for the Award of Undergraduate Degrees and in the Interpretation Section of the Academic Rules and Regulations.

### 2. Entry Requirements

- 2.1 To enter the **Bachelor of Nursing** programme, a student should have enrolled in the Higher Diploma in Nursing or Mental Health Nursing programme, and should have completed studying the programme.
- 2.2 To enter the **Bachelor of Nursing** programme through Pathway 1, a student should have registered with the Nursing Council of Hong Kong as Registered Nurse.

### 3. Bachelor of Nursing (BN)

- 3.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Bachelor of Nursing**, a student shall:
  - 3.1.1 comply with the Regulations for Admission, Registration and Maintenance of Status; and
  - 3.1.2 comply with the Regulations for the Award of Undergraduate Degrees; and
  - 3.1.3 have been deemed to satisfy in full the specified pre-entry requirements for the programme of study; and
  - 3.1.4 successfully complete the prescribed courses of studies.
- 3.2 For the degree of **Bachelor of Nursing**, the University has prescribed that a student must:
  - 3.2.1 successfully complete the Higher Diploma in Nursing or Higher Diploma in Mental Health Nursing; and
  - 3.2.2 successfully complete 30 credits from Table 1.

### 4. Bachelor of Nursing (through Pathway 1) (BN1)

- 4.1 To be eligible for the award of the degree of **Bachelor of Nursing**, a student who entered the programme through pathway 1 shall:
  - 4.1.1 comply with the Regulations for Admission, Registration and Maintenance of Status; and
  - 4.1.2 comply with the Regulations for the Award of Undergraduate Degrees; and
  - 4.1.3 have been deemed to satisfy in full the specified pre-entry requirements for the programme of study; and
  - 4.1.4 successfully complete the prescribed courses of studies.

4.2 For the degree of **Bachelor of Nursing**, the University has prescribed that a student who entered the programme through pathway 1 must:

4.2.1 successfully complete 30 credits from Table 1; and

4.2.2 successfully complete 10 credits from any Middle or Higher level courses offered by the University.
