- Assume the roles of nursing management in the complex healthcare environment;
- Demonstrate leadership to develop new initiatives for quality and safety in nursing practice;
- Appraise critically the research evidence to guide nursing practice;
- Apply scientific methods to inquire and resolve challenges in nursing practice.



Programme Features

- **Specialisation in Nursing**

Equip students with requisite knowledge, skills and competencies for advanced nursing practice in a specialty area.

- **Innovative Learning and Teaching Strategies**

Provide the best learning experience through lectures, seminars, tutorials, laboratory sessions, clinical visits and advanced simulation education which offers a realistic and immersive learning experiences.

- **Flexible Learning**

Allow Postgraduate Diploma early exit. Students will be able to obtain a Postgraduate Diploma qualification in 12 months part-time.

- **Course Exemption for Hospital Authority's Post-registration Certificate Course Qualification(s)**

Course exemption through **Pathway 1** Entry is offered for Advanced Respiratory Nursing, Advanced Renal Care or Palliative Care specialisation students with relevant Post-registration Certificate Course (PRCC) qualification(s).

- **Professional Collaboration**

Collaborate with the **Society for the Promotion of Hospice Care** in offering the teaching and clinical training for Palliative Care specialisation.



Admission Requirements

- **Local applicants:** Registered Nurse with valid professional and practicing certificates issued by Nursing Council of Hong Kong; or
- **Non-local applicants:** Nurse with recognised professional and practicing qualification issued by the relevant professional body outside Hong Kong; and
- Have a recognised Bachelor's degree in Nursing or health-related discipline, or equivalent qualification; and
- Fulfil the University's English language proficiency requirements

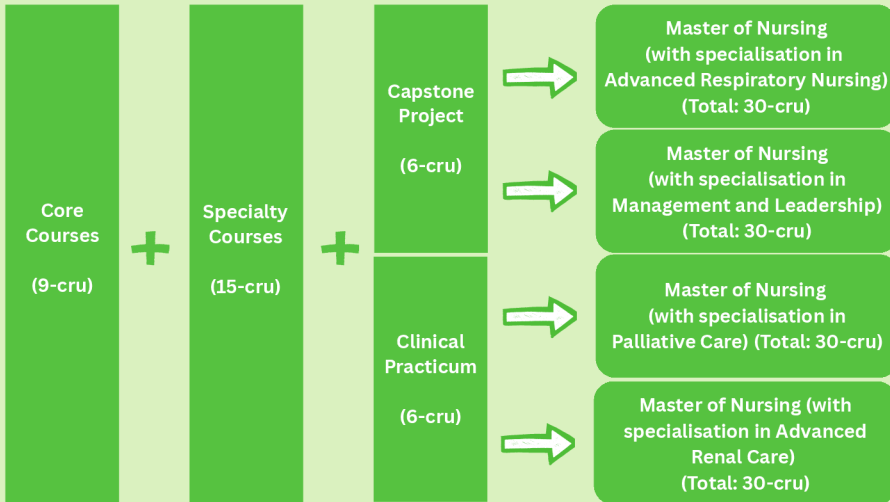
Additional entry requirement for **Pathway 1** applicants:

- Possess a Post-registration Certificate Course qualification in Respiratory Nursing (for specialisation in Advanced Respiratory Nursing), Palliative Care Nursing (for specialisation in Palliative Care), or Renal Nursing (for specialisation in Advanced Renal Care), awarded by the Institute of Advanced Nursing Studies, Hospital Authority



Programme Structure

Students are expected to complete three core courses, four to five specialty courses (according to specialisation) and a capstone project/clinical practicum.

- Graduates will be able to enhance professional development and gain competitive edge with more career advancement opportunities.
