Collecting exclusive souvenirs:

- Eligibility for souvenir collection: All Full-time HKMU Undergraduate and Postgraduate students
- Quota applies to each event date, redeem of souvenir is on first come first served basis.

Steps:

- Visit the designated spots in the career fair and collect six stamps in total to complete the postcard
- Present the completed postcard in Booth 18: SAO Souvenir Counter for A. one chance of the lucky draw for souvenir and B. One lucky draw ticket (*lucky draw ticket is only applicable to HKMU Undergraduate students)
- Student should present 1. a valid Student ID card, and 2. Completed postcard with stamps for the lucky draw of souvenirs
- Eligible student can collect souvenirs more than one time. There is no limitation on the numbers of souvenir to be collected by students

Lottery of attractive grand prizes:

- Eligibility:

- Winners should fulfill the following requirements:
 - Be physically present in the prize giving ceremony at 4:30pm on 26 Mar 2026 (Thursday) at Agile Sports Hall, JCC, HKMU
 - Be able to present identification documents (e.g. a valid student ID card) to proof the student identity
 - Any person who does not fulfil the above criteria for the entirety will automatically be disqualified from participating in the grand prize lottery.

Steps:

- After a postcard is completed, eligible students (HKMU undergraduate students) can collect one lottery ticket together with the souvenir
- To redeem extra lottery tickets, students are required to attend the listed career talks at the career fair. Pre-registration is required.
- Students can receive one ticket for grand prize lottery if they attended one Career Enrichment Talks/Workshops. Each student can receive up to 5 lottery tickets if they attend all 5 workshops
- Attendance for the career talks will be recorded at the back of the postcard
- Student can redeem extra lottery tickets at Booth 18: SAO Souvenir Counter
- Operation time for Lottery ticket counter: 12pm – 5pm for 24 Mar; 12pm – 4pm for 25 – 26 Mar.

- The more career enrichment talks participated in, the higher chance to win the prizes
- Eligible students should fill in the valid student ID clearly on the postcard and the lottery ticket
- Any lottery ticket without a valid stamp will be considered invalid
- Redemption and distribution of extra lottery tickets is only valid for each event date.
 - For example, if student attended the career talks on 24 Mar students can only redeem extra lottery tickets on 24 Mar. Student CANNOT redeem extra lottery tickets on 25 Mar if they only attended career talks on 24 Mar.

- Winners should collect the prizes at SAO office by appointment. SAO staff will contact winners for details by 30 Mar 2026. Students need to pay attention to their own student emails for the method of collection. SAO will NOT notify the winners by phone or any other means.
