
Study Tour to Finland 2019 – embracing innovation in high-tech economy

Date: 20th to 28th October 2019

Location: Helsinki and Rovaniemi, Finland

Type: Study Tour

This study tour was organized by the Electronics and Computer Engineering Team and supported by the IEEE OUHK Student Branch. The study tour was sponsored by the Subsidy Scheme for International Exchanges (OUIE) and Reaching Out Award (ROA). Objectives were to provide students of OUHK with the opportunity to: (i) Gain a better understanding of the current technological developments in Finland; (ii) Exchange ideas with people who are in the academic and industrial sectors in Finland; and (iii) Appreciate how innovation benefits the society and contributes to building a high-tech and sustainable economy.
