

Practical Information for Attending ICOFE 2016

Warm greetings from the Open University of Hong Kong (OUHK)! We look forward to welcoming you to OUHK in Hong Kong SAR, China. A set of practical information has been prepared for your reference. You are strongly encouraged to read all the points below to prepare your trip to ICOFE 2016.

A. Travel to Hong Kong

A1. Climate and weather

Hong Kong has a sub-tropical climate with distinct seasons. In its summer (May to August), the weather is often sunny and also common to be hot $(27^{\circ}\text{C} - 32^{\circ}\text{C} \text{ on average})$ and humid with occasional showers and thunderstorms. It is advisable to bring an umbrella with you just in case you need it. You can find the weather forecast from the Hong Kong Observatory website (http://www.hko.gov.hk/wxinfo/currwx/fnd.htm).

A2. Currency exchange services

The legal currency in Hong Kong is the Hong Kong dollar (HKD), which is pegged to the US dollar at a rate of about HKD7.8 to USD1.0. Slightly lower rates may be used at currency exchange shops (including those at the Hong Kong International Airport).

A3. Electricity and voltage

The standard electrical voltage in Hong Kong is 220 volts AC, 50Hz. Some hotel bathrooms also have outlets for 100 volts. For the electric appliances, you may need a transformer. The majority of electrical outlets in Hong Kong take a three-pronged UK-style plug. You can buy an adaptor for your electrical equipment at most convenience stores.

A4. Transportation

Travelling around Hong Kong is easy and convenient. There will be no transportation service between the airport and hotels. However, at the airport, you may easily find public transport means to your destinations. You can find the transport network connecting the airport with downtown from this leaflet:

B4. Information for oral presenters

You can check your respective presentation slot(s) with regard to its time and venue at the ICOFE 2016 conference website: http://icofe2016.ouhk.edu.hk/e-programme.html.

You will most likely have up to 10 minutes for your presentation and 5 minutes for the Q&A. (The actual time available for each paper presenter may vary.) Please follow relevant instructions from the Chair of your session.

Please arrive at your presentation venue and report to the session Chair at least 10 minutes before the start of the session. You are also requested to load your presentation slides onto the computer in the presentation room in advance to ensure smooth transition between presentations.

We expect all papers to be effectively presented with a clear and comprehensive set of presentation slides. No word-for-word reading from a script will be acceptable. Oral presentations must be well prepared and spontaneous. Each should focus on key points only.

B5. Internet connectivity
