

# Update Saved Secure ID/Password on macOS

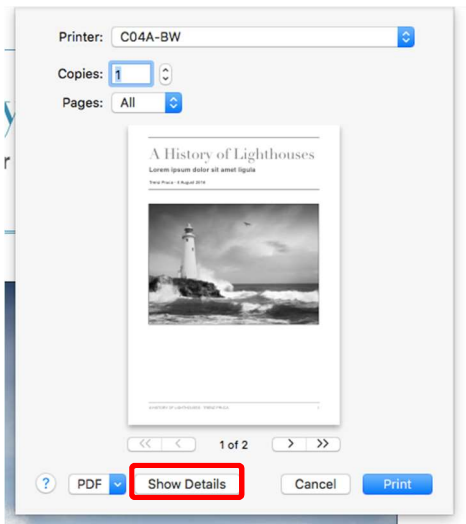
This guide outlines the steps required to update the saved Secure ID/Password for Secure Print at Apple OS X / macOS for HKMU Wireless Printing Service on campus.

1. When you send a print job and no Secure Print dialogue pops up which means you may have already stored the ID and Password at your Mac, i.e. **“Save Settings”** has been selected in example at right.

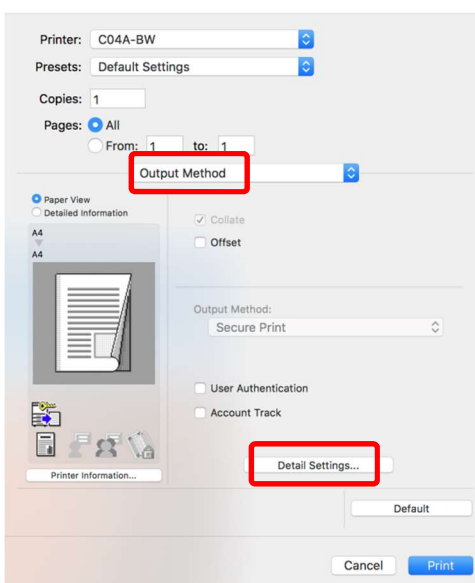


You'll need to follow below steps if you intend to update the saved Secure Print ID and/or Password for a selected printer at your Mac.

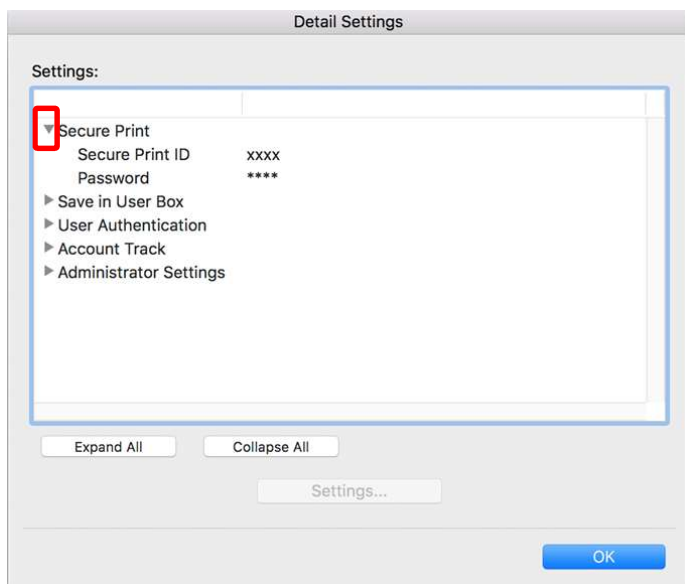
2. At application, click **“File”** -> **“Print”** -> select desire printer -> **“Show Details”** button



3. At the section drop-down menu, select **Output Method** -> **Detail Settings...**



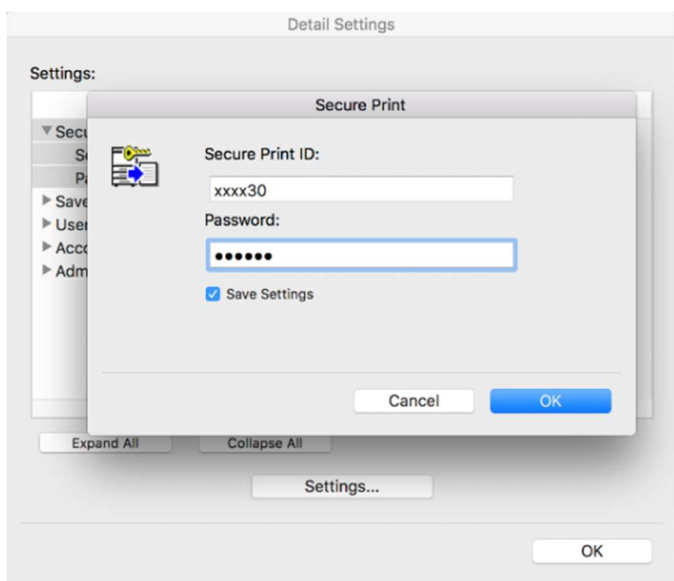
4. At “Detail Settings”, expand the **Secure Print** by click on the triangle at its left



5. Double click anywhere on **Secure Print**, **Secure Print ID** or **Password** to bring up the “Secure Print” dialogue box.

To change:

- enter a new Secure Print ID in the **Secure Print ID** text box, or/and;
- enter a new Password in the **Password** text box.



Click “**OK**” button to accept the change.

6. Repeat the steps onto another printer one by one.
